

History

USAARL was established in 1962 to accomplish research in support of Army aviation and airborne activities, and to provide a central aeromedical research and reference library. USAARL's library specializes in the field of aviation medicine. The library collection, which consists of over 32,000 items, covers such topics as acoustics, biomedical engineering, human factors, neurosciences, psychology, and vision. The focus of the collection changes to reflect the focus of USAARL's researchers.

The library has materials in a variety of formats such as hardcopy, digital (online and CD), and microform. The library physically houses approximately 5,000 book titles, 100 current journal subscriptions, and back issues of scientific and technical journals covering almost 100 years. We also maintain a growing collection of government technical reports including those generated by USAARL scientists.






