## *Volunteers Needed!*

The US Army Aeromedical Research Laboratory (USAARL) is currently recruiting and briefing individuals interested in becoming a USAARL research subject. We are looking for male and female H-60 rated aviators with current, unrestricted Department of the Army clearance (DD 2992) to fly.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Males and Females between the ages of 19 and 60
- Current rating on the H-60 platform
- Possession of an approved flight helmet.
- Subjects must be fluent in English



### **Compensation:**

May receive \$400 upon completion of study.

\*Note – you must be off duty during days 1 and 2 and on duty during day 3 (flight day).



### **You Will Be Asked To:**

- Conduct a one-hour mission each day (one day in flight simulator and one day for actual H-60 flight)
- Test neck strength and range of motion
- Have your flight performance graded by a USAARL instructor pilot



### **Time:**

A total of 5.5 hours over three days.

Day 1 = 1 hour

Days 2 & 3 (Non-consecutive) = 2.25 hours each day
